Secretary mag Lucy has a date for diary

She's heading for top London hotel 'at our version of the Oscars'

A SHEPPERTON publisher has been nominated for a national business award for her work on her secretarial magazine.

Lucy Brazier has been shortlisted as a finalist for the Independent Publisher Business Magazine of the Year award as part of the Professional Publishers Association (PPA) which Mrs Brazier said felt like 'the Oscars of the magazine industry?

The 44-year-old chief executive of Marcham Publishing has been in the industry for 26 years, and hopes her work on the Executive Secretary magazine will pay off at the awards ceremony on Friday December 6.

"We're unique as we're a global magazine for secretaries and we don't advertise, which is very rare," said Mrs Brazier, of Wood Road.

"I operate from my home and to be in a line-up with five large publishers is amazing," she said.

The magazine started when Mrs Brazier carried on from the work of a newsletter especially for personal assistants.

Describing the magazine, Mrs Brazier said: "It's a weird cross between a



magazine and a textbook, like a Harvard Business Review for PAs." The awards ceremony will be held at the five-star Montcalm Hotel in Great Cumberland Place, in the West End of London on Friday, December 6.
