e've reviewed other venues from the camp of Ed and Tom Martin including The Well in St John Street and The Botanist in Sloane Square. They have a knack of delivering quality London pubs and bars that appeal to their local neighbourhoods. The Chiswell Street Dining Rooms represents a slight change of direction for Ed and Tom: this venue will become an integral part of the soon to open Montcalm London City Hotel, and they will be responsible for the entire food and beverage operation for the hotel, including room service and an as yet unnamed British Pub adjoined to the building. The hotel is on the site of the original Whitbread Brewery, which opened in the mid eighteenth century. The wooden panelled ground floor room benefits from plenty of natural daylight as its rectangular shape runs alongside Chiswell Street, which is near to the Barbican and a stone's throw from Moorgate Station. The bar leads seamlessly into the dining room and both spaces are 'connected' by a minimally designed yet elegant interior. It's all very light and comfortable, if slightly formal, but as a business hotel's main restaurant, it will work perfectly well.
